# CAMP HARBOR VIEW™

Camp Harbor View™ is a summer day camp for Boston boys and girls between the ages of 11 and 14. The camp is located on Long Island in Boston Harbor, and is accessible by bus and automobile from the Neponset area via a bridge that connects the island to the mainland.

The camp is operated by Boys & Girls Clubs of Boston under agreement with the City of Boston and the Camp Harbor View Foundation, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation established in 2007 for the purpose of creating the camp. The camp will host two groups of approximately 340 boys and girls each, for a period of four weeks. The camp will operate Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The first session will run from June 28 through July 22, 2010. The second session will run from July 27 through August 20, 2010.

**Note: There will be no camp on July 5, July 23, or July 26, 2010.**

Camp Harbor View will provide a fun and safe environment for youths to challenge themselves, make new friends, and experience a world beyond their neighborhoods.

The camp experiences will include athletics, arts, leadership development, aquatics, and expanded education. Activities will include arts and crafts, tennis, basketball, hiking, a ropes course, swimming, and sailing. The camp will also provide each camper with three nutritious meals per day. An on-site health facility will be staffed by healthcare professionals during camp hours of operation, to attend to any medical issues that may arise.

Campers will be picked up by bus each morning at 8:00 a.m. at designated areas within Boston neighborhoods. Buses will return campers to those designated areas each evening, departing the camp at 6:00 p.m. following the evening meal.

The fee for each camper is \$5 for the four-week session. This fee should **NOT** be sent with the pre-application. If your child is accepted to Camp Harbor View, the fee will be due with the full application.

*This camp must comply with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health and be licensed by the local board of health.*

**This is only a pre-application and does NOT guarantee a spot in the program.**

If there is additional information that you believe we should have when selecting new campers, please enclose a letter with the pre-application. Upon acceptance to the camp, each youngster will receive a welcome kit that includes three T-shirts that must be worn every day.

In addition to the summer camp, there will be off-season programming for the campers. This includes nights at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Boston, weekend reunions at the camp, and some case management services as needed.
